Revised Budget 22.23 Commentary

Income

Grants: include Cleansing Grant from Mid Suffolk plus a grant from Suffolk County Council of £566 to cover footpath cutting. **Grants**: in 2020/21 a sum of £528 was received from Mid Suffolk as a precept grant to offset the temporary reduction in tax base.

Cemetery income: figure is based on the average income of the past 5 years.

Health Centre rent: District Valuer recommends rent of £22,400 (assumed it will be backdated to November 2020)

Reserves: Shed User & Youth Council £2975 and Cemetery £2000 if insufficient fees

Expenditure

Administration: includes all agreed contractual changes and increase in minimum wage **Administration:** figures include all Govt. proposed changes to National Insurance contributions **Administration/General:** includes amounts which are paid for from health centre rent, such as share of: insurance and admin costs etc.

Health Centre: only cost for assessments, repairs and maintenance are included here (see note above)

Health Centre: since PC agreement reached in 2017, 10% of rent collected is offset against precept/expenditure

Highways: includes payments for grass cutting of footpaths on behalf of SCC.

Other: contribution to build fund for permissive path and fitness track have been removed, these will now be

be funded from loan repayment savings from 2024/25 or CIL/S.106 obligations

Other: cemetery and chapel upgrades have been moved to CIL projects.

Other: £2500 included as it is expected Community Shed funds will be transferred.

Other: no contingency figure has been included this year as Reserves were considered high enough to cover

any contingency required.

Overall: all other areas are increased in line with inflation.
